## DTECH BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION

### Qualification Structure

This qualification consists of a research project that has to be recorded in the form of a thesis. A pre-condition for the thesis to be accepted for examination is for two articles, based on the research and approved by the supervisor, to have been submitted to a peer evaluated accredited journal. A draft version of the article, which acknowledgement of receipt by the journal, should be submitted with the thesis.

### What are the Pros and Cons of the DTech

At the doctoral level students are expected to research and report on a specific gap in the body of knowledge within any specific area of Business Administration. The researcher will work with close guidance from academic supervisor(s) to establish new knowledge in the chosen field of study. The thesis which is presented for examination will show substantial empirical and other evidence and arguments in support of the conclusions reached. Often, the recommendations arising out of such a study will inform and advance public policy, as well as, having the potential to transform the body of knowledge in a significant way.

### Duration

A minimum of 2 years and a maximum of 5 years for the research project.

### Entrance Requirements

- A Magister Technologiae: Business Administration, or
- A Master's Degree in Business Administration (MBA), or
- A qualification at NQF level 8 (old) or NQF level 9 (new) in an appropriate management field
- Submission of preliminary doctoral proposal
- An average of at least 60% for the class work and the Magister Technologiae dissertation
