Dress code for graduates

The Tshwane University of Technology regards a graduation ceremony as a prestige occasion and would like to request graduates to dress accordingly. The correct dress code is formal or traditional dress. Please refrain from wearing denims, T-shirts and sport shoes (takkies) during the graduation ceremonies. TUT would like to suggest the following to be worn at the graduation ceremonies:

For men:

Academic regalia, namely the prescribed gown and hood.

Underneath, a long-sleeved dress shirt and tie (no T-shirts), neat pants (no jeans) and shoes (no sport shoes/takkies) should be worn.

For women:

Academic regalia, namely the prescribed gown and hood.

Underneath, a neat skirt or trousers and a blouse or shirt (no T-shirts) or a dress and neat sandals or shoes (no sport shoes/takkies) should be worn.
